BUSINESS ITEMS

History Harvest:

Despite the low attendance for the 2025 HH, HPC will plan a 2026 HH after the online catalog on the city website opens, promoting residents to contribute to the archives.

Historic Needs in Hoschton:

The unanimous decision was the need for an Archives room for collected material and for visitors to attend when wanting history information about Hoschton. An extensive discussion followed talking about historical buildings throughout the city – Darby house, Corn Crib, the vintage homes for sale and the historic appearance of the drive through the city. Blankenship said she would be developing a proposal to have the Darby Building and Corn Crib set up on the acres she sold to the city for a free space. Signs for the businesses were mentioned to promote downtown businesses with the signs being uniform particularly on Hwy 53. Alos discussed was an additional mural for the brick wall at the end of the building housing Slices. This is a return to a project handled with the first "Welcome" mural.
